OUR TEAM

- ❖ **Physicians** direct the team in developing goals to guide treatment plans, order rehabilitation therapy, and recommend medications and assistive equipment.
- ❖ **Physical and Occupational Therapists** provide strengthening, neuromuscular re-education, balance training, and strategies to improve activities of daily living.
- ❖ **Clinical Coordinators** educate children and families about spasticity and discuss treatment options, as well as schedule and coordinate all interventions and referrals.
- ❖ **Child Life Specialists** help children cope with fears about medical procedures and use distraction techniques during procedures.
- ❖ **Orthotists** design, develop, create, and fit custom orthoses to maximize physical function.
