

Work Restrictions for Non-Direct Care Providers

This does not include any staff members who work directly with children or work in an area where children may be present.

I am confirmed positive with COVID-19. (Individuals who have tested positive through any type of COVID-19 test)	
Vaccination Status	
Fully Vaccinated, Up to Date^o, or Unvaccinated	May return after 10 days[^] (with improving symptoms) and fever-free for 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medicine)

I was exposed to COVID-19.		
Vaccination Status	I have symptoms.	I'm asymptomatic.
Fully Vaccinated or Up to Date^o	May return with negative test AND 24 hours after fever and other symptoms resolve (without the use of fever-reducing medicine) OR If choosing not to test, quarantine for 10 days[^] , then may return 24 hours after fever and other symptoms resolve (without the use of fever-reducing medicine).	May return to work but must mask at all times through day 10 [^] .
Unvaccinated	Quarantine for 5 days.[^] After 5 days, may return with negative test* AND 24 hours after fever and other symptoms resolve (without the use of fever-reducing medicine). OR If choosing not to test, quarantine for 10 days[^] , then may return 24 hours after fever and other symptoms resolve (without the use of fever-reducing medicine).	Quarantine for 5 days.[^] May return to work on day 6 [^] but must mask at all times through day 10 [^] .

I have illness symptoms and tested negative for COVID-19, or am waiting for test results, or chose not to test.		
Vaccination Status	Tested Negative	Waiting for Test Results or Not Testing
Fully Vaccinated or Up to Date^o	May return 24 hours after fever and other symptoms resolve (without the use of fever-reducing medicine)	May return after 10 days[^] (with improving symptoms) and fever-free for 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medicine)
Unvaccinated	If no exposure, may return 24 hours after fever and other symptoms resolve (without the use of fever-reducing medicine) OR If exposed, quarantine for 5 days.[^] After 5 days, may return with negative test* AND 24 hours after fever and other symptoms resolve (without the use of fever-reducing medicine).	May return after 10 days[^] (with improving symptoms) and fever-free for 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medicine)

[^] For calculating days:

- 1) For those with infection consider day symptoms started (or first positive test if asymptomatic) as day 0
- 2) For those with exposure consider the most recent day you were exposed as day 0

* Negative test result within **48 hours** before returning to work

^o **Fully vaccinated** refers to someone who has had all recommended doses in their primary series.

Up to date refers to someone who has had completed their primary series and all recommended boosters.
